CURRICULUM OVERVIEW

Summer Term 1 - Year 3 Codlin Class



READING

During reading lessons, we will explore Africa, Amazing Africa, to develop our skills in making inference with evidence, summarising key ideas and develop our understanding of vocabulary.



WRITING

We will be looking at Limericks by Edward Lear. We will also be looking at Leon and the place between. We will be creating a persuasive poster, setting description and work towards writing our own fantasy narrative.



MATHS

In Maths this half-term, we will be focusing on adding and subtracting of numbers across 10 in our lessons. We will also be learning numbers up to 1000.



SCIENCE

We will learn about rocks. We will learning how fossils are formed when things that have lived are trapped within rock. We will also be discussing that soils are made from rocks and organic matter.



HISTORY

We will be learning about the changes in Britain from the Stone Age to the Iron Age. We will be looking at what an 'age' is, focusing on Prehistoric Britain, the Neolithic Revolution and the Iron age.



ART

We will learning about gestural drawing with charcoal. This will include making loose, gestural drawings with charcoal, and exploring drama and performance.



PHYSICAL EDUCATION (PE)

In PE we will be improving our physical skills, particularly sending and receiving balls to use within target games.



RELIGIOUS EDUCATION (RE)

In RE, we will be learning about Islam and how a Muslim person lives their life.



MUSIC

Using 'space' as our theme of inspiration, we will be exploring dynamics, timbre, tempo and motifs.



COMPUTING

In programming lessons, we will be using Scratch Junior on the iPads to create and debug algorithms.



PERSONAL, SOCIAL, HEALTH AND ECONOMIC EDUCATION (PSHE)

Our focus this half term will be on economic wellbeing.



FRENCH

Our theme will be 'Myself' and we will be learning vocabulary and phrases linked to describing ourselves such as our names, ages, where we live and what we like.
