



READING

Waterloo class will explore fiction through *Cosmic* by Frank Cottrell-Boyce, developing inference & comprehension skills. For non-fiction, we study *Black and British* by David Olusoga, discussing important themes with growing confidence and curiosity.



WRITING

We will explore poetry through *Star* by Michaela Morgan, focusing on imagery. We will study *Freedom Bird* and *Hidden Figures*, using these texts to inspire narrative writing, develop character descriptions and understand historical themes.



MATHS

Children will deepen understanding of place value, working with numbers to at least 1,000,000. They use formal methods for addition, subtraction, multiplication & division. Children begin exploring fractions.



SCIENCE

Children will learn about Earth and Space, the solar system, planets and the movement of the Earth and Moon. This links to the key reading and writing texts, encouraging curiosity and imagination.



HISTORY

Children will explore the exciting world of the Vikings! They learn about Viking invasions, their impressive longboats and the reasons behind their journeys to Britain.



ART

During art lessons, children study maps and typography, focusing on how fonts, symbols and images convey meaning.



PHYSICAL EDUCATION (PE)

Children will learn to play tag rugby during PE. The key focus will be coordination, control and cooperation.



RELIGIOUS EDUCATION (RE)

In RE, we will be considering the question, "What does it mean if Christians believe God is holy and loving?"



MUSIC

Using Egyptian music as inspiration, children will study composition and notation.



COMPUTING

In our Computing lessons, children will study computing systems and networks; with a focus on developing skills to efficiently search for accurate information online.



PERSONAL, SOCIAL, HEALTH AND ECONOMIC EDUCATION (PSHE)

Our focus this half term will be on families and relationships.



FRENCH

Children will develop their French skills with a focus on the seasons. They will broaden their vocabulary and practise pronunciation with confidence.
