



READING

This term, children will read *The Undefeated* and *The Story of Flight*. They will focus on improving reading fluency, summarising key ideas, and retrieving information. They'll also explore new vocabulary and learn how to use evidence from the text to support their answers.



WRITING

This half term, children will use the texts *Tar Beach*, *Until I Met Dudley*, and the poem *The Sound of Music* to inspire a range of writing. They will write character descriptions, formal letters, dialogue, a playscript, a short explanatory paragraph, and poetry.



MATHS

Children will strengthen their skills in column addition and subtraction, working with numbers up to 4 digits. Develop a deeper understanding of place value, focusing on numbers up to 10,000. Build fluency in times tables, aiming for quick and accurate recall of multiplication facts.



SCIENCE

This term, children will explore electricity. They'll learn to identify electrical appliances, build simple circuits, understand how switches control circuits and recognise materials that conduct electricity



HISTORY

This term, children will study Ancient Greece. They'll learn about Greek daily life, key achievements, and how Greek ideas have influenced the modern Western world.



ART

During art lessons, children study maps and typography, focusing on how fonts, symbols and images convey meaning.



PHYSICAL EDUCATION (PE)

Children will learn to play tag rugby during PE. The key focus will be coordination, control and cooperation.



RELIGIOUS EDUCATION (RE)

In RE, Children will learn about the Gospel, the teachings of Jesus, and how Christians follow his example through kindness, charity, and stories like the Good Samaritan.



MUSIC

Using Egyptian music as inspiration, children will study composition and notation.



COMPUTING

In our Computing lessons we will learn how to work collaboratively on documents, give and respond to feedback, create engaging presentations, design Google Forms, and organise data using spreadsheets.



PERSONAL, SOCIAL, HEALTH AND ECONOMIC EDUCATION (PSHE)

Our focus this half term will be on families and relationships.



FRENCH

Children will develop their French skills with a focus on the seasons. They will broaden their vocabulary and practise pronunciation with confidence.
