CURRICULUM OVERVIEW

Autumn 2 Pippin Class



READING

In phonics we'll continue to learn our sounds, to become fluent readers with expression. Children will be listening to and discussing the story: Hotel Flamingo by Alex Milway



WRITING

We will look at rhyming patterns with the poem November Night Countdown by Moira Andrew and introduce apostrophes with our text Tadpole's Promise by Jeanne Willis and Tony Ross.



MATHS

We'll be working on our fluency within 10 and looking at different methods of addition and subtraction from a 2 digit number.



SCIENCE

We'll explore Animals including humans. We'll notice that animals, including humans, have offspring which grow into adults and find out about the basic needs of animals, including humans, for survival.



GEOGRAPHY

Our title this half term is Why is our World Wonderful? We will be using maps to locate human and physical features such as oceans and seas, sketching maps and collecting data.



DESIGN AND TECHNOLOGY

Year 1 and 2 will be making a moving monster, exploring levers, linkages and pivots.



PHYSICAL EDUCATION (PE)

In PE, year 1 and 2 will create a dance routine - moving to the beat and creating their own ideas and Tag Rugby - learning to pass, throw and play simple games.



RELIGIOUS EDUCATION (RE)

In RE, year 1 and 2 will be learning about Christianity - What is the good news that Christians say Jesus will bring?



MUSIC

In Music years 1 and 2 will be looking at orchestral instruments- listening to and exploring how sound and dynamic effects can tell a story.



COMPUTING

In Computing we will be learning the beginnings of programming - what is an algorithm, what are decomposition and abstraction and how does a loop make their code more efficient?



PERSONAL, SOCIAL, HEALTH AND ECONOMIC EDUCATION (PSHE)

This half term year 1 and 2 will continue their work on families and relationships -and then move onto Health and Wellbeing.
