READING

In reading we will be focusing on understanding texts. We will finish our books from last half term, then be reading *The Magic and Mystery of Trees* by Jen Green.



WRITING

Our poetry focus this half term is *The Owl and the Pussycat* by Edward Lear. We will follow this with story writing inspired by *House held up by Trees*, by Ted Kooser and *A Journey Home* by Frann Preston-Gannon.



MATHS

We will continue 2D and 3D shape. Then move on to Money, time, position and direction, along side lots of practice of our skills learnt so far in year 2.



SCIENCE

This half term will be a review of the core knowledge learnt through year 2, with experiments and investigations to get us thinking!



GEOGRAPHY

We will spend a few more weeks completing out Historical work on significant individuals, then move onto Geography - What is it like to live by the coast?
