



READING

WRITING

We will be using the text *The Explorer* to inspire our writing, as well as revisiting and editing our written work in readiness for writing assessment.



MATHS

We will be working on project based investigations using the range of skills we have learned as mathematicians in Year 6. Our first project will be to create a bakery business, scale our recipes, design packaging and create a web page.



SCIENCE
