CURRICULUM OVERVIEW

Summer Term 2 - Reception Golden Class



COMMUNICATION AND LANGUAGE

In phonics we will be continuing our learning of the sset 2 sounds.
Children will be listening to and discussing stories whilst learning new vocabulary - The naughty bus, Mr Gumpy's motor car, and The rainbow fish.



LITERACY

We will be focusing on forming the set 1 sound letters correctly during this term. We practise the correct pencil grip and posture to support letter formation. We will also be beginning to write simple sentences through transcription.



MATHEMATICS

children will be consolidating their understanding of number, particularly counting, comparing quantities, and recognising patterns within numbers to 10. They also begin to explore spatial reasoning, shapes, and simple measures, developing their mathematical thinking through practical activities, problem-solving, and talk.



UNDERSTANDING THE WORLD

This term, we will explore a range of environments around the world, and learn about stories that are important to different groups of people.



PERSONAL, SOCIAL, AND EMOTIONAL

We will be learning about our wellbeing, what this means and how we can look after it.



EXPRESSIVE ARTS AND DESIGN

We will be thinking about the structure of boats, how we can build a boat out of recycled items that will float.



PHYSICAL DEVELOPMENT

This term children will be developing their skills in running, using obstacles, and team races.
